- A. Staff contacted other counties that prohibit solar farms in the Shoreland District, and this was what they said the reasoning was:
  - -Was to mirror what they were finding in other county ordinances around the time they created their ordinance.
  - A few environmental people thought additional protection measures should be incorporated into our solar language.
  - The thoughts/ideas pertained to the appearance would take away from the natural setting, potential impact on wildlife/waterfowl, additional glare off the water, etc.
  - It was the aesthetics of solar panels and they are more of an industrial use which that county did not allow in shoreland.
  - Shoreland is more valued for residential. This County saw the potential for development of housing around the lakes. People who already live on the lakes weren't fans of being surrounded by solar.

#### IV. Public Lands Setback

This was brought up by legislature, but it may not go anywhere. However, our County Parks Director had requested that we implement a setback to public lands and wildlife preservation areas like how we have a setback to residences.
