**A RESOLUTION WAIVING WRIGHT COUNTY'S JURISDICTION TO CARRY OUT COMPLIANCE PROVISIONS OF MINNESOTA STATUTES 103B.101, SUBDIVISION 12A AND 103F.48**

WHEREAS, during the 2015 First Special Session, the 89<sup>th</sup> Legislature adopted Chapter 4, creating the water quality buffer initiative; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 4 authorizes a county to assume jurisdiction over the compliance provisions of the water quality buffer initiative; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 4 authorizes the Board of Water and Soil Resources to assume jurisdiction over the compliance provisions of the water quality buffer initiative in a county that by resolution has opted out of assuming jurisdiction; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, Wright County, waives its jurisdiction to carry out the compliance provisions of Minnesota Statutes 103B.101, subdivision 12a and 103F.48.
