The effects of severe weather are felt every year by many Americans. Trained spotters provide essential information for all types of weather hazards, the main responsibility of a spotter is to identify and describe severe local storms.

The classes are **FREE** and open to the public. A class is about 2 ½ hours in length and will include a slide and video program that teaches potential spotters about severe storm structure, and how to identify cloud features and other environmental clues to identify severe storms and tornadoes. Instructors are trained by the National Weather Service. Qualifies for POST credits.
