SERVICES AVAILABLE BY THE WOW PROGRAM

APPOINTMENT RECOMMENDED FOR:

- -- **Immunizations (Fee Varies):** Eligible children: No health insurance or insurance that does not cover vaccines; can bill MA or Minnesota Care. Eligible adults: No health insurance or insurance that does not cover vaccines. Private pay adult: Vaccines are limited to Pneumococcal. Flu shots: Most insurance plans can be billed.
- -- **Pregnancy test (Free):** Urine sample to determine a presence of the hormone hCG.
- -- **Mantoux (\$35):** Skin test for Tuberculosis; requires follow-up visit in 48-72 hrs. to determine results.
- -- Fluoride Application (Suggested \$5): Applied to prevent tooth decay. Billable for children on MA or MnCare.
- -- **Non Fasting Cholesterol (\$25):** Finger stick to determine Total Cholesterol, HDL, and glucose.
- -- **Blood Glucose (Suggested \$5):** Finger stick to determine risk for diabetes. An 8-hour fast is suggested. Billable for children on MA or MnCare.
- -- **Hemoglobin A1C (Fee Varies by eligibility):** Finger stick to **i**dentify average blood glucose levels for past 2-3 months. No fasting required.
- -- **Hemoglobin (Suggested \$5):** Finger stick to determine level of hemoglobin in blood. Billable for children on MA or MnCare.

APPOINTMENT REQUIRED FOR:

- -- Child Car Seats (Suggested \$10): Correct use, placement, and recall check. Checks can also be done at Wright County Health & Human Services building, call (763) 682-7516 for more information.
- -- **Blood Lead (Suggested \$20):** Done at Wright County Health & Human Services building, call (763) 682-7516 for more information. BIllable for children on MA or MnCare.

OTHER SERVICES:

- -- Blood Pressure (Free): To assess risk of hypertension.
- -- **Health/Community Resources:** Local services and health education materials.
- -- Well Testing Kit (Free): Take home kit for Nitrites and Coliform Bacteria. A fee is applied when returned to Wright County Planning & Zoning.
- -- Radon Test Kit (\$5): Take home test for radon in the home. Short term kits available.
