Family planning is the voluntary planning and action taken by a person to prevent, delay, or achieve a pregnancy.

Medical exams and testing for sexually transmitted infections are performed at contracted clinics located in different areas within Wright County.

The Wright County Family Planning Program is open to people of all ages who are uninsured, under-insured or do not wish to have these services billed to private insurance.

Wright County Health and Human Services provides equal access to programs and services without regard to race, color, age, gender, handicap, marital status, affectional preferences, criminal record, or national origin.
