- One Saturday a month 9 a.m. - 1 p.m.

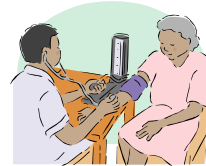
Current Services provided by Public Health Nurses and Registered Nurses:

Public Health

Wright County Public Health (WCPH) has been protecting, maintaining, and improving the health of county residents since 1951.

Health services are provided in Health Care Management, Family Health, and Health Promotion. Environmental health services are shared between Public Health and Planning and Zoning. An EMS (Emergency Management System) Workgroup is coordinated through Public Health.

Health Care Management

PHNs screen for and coordinate community services with income eligible county residents who have chronic health conditions and are disabled, elderly or a child with special needs. These services

- Help residents stay in their homes
 - Give support to caregivers
 - Refer to community resources
 - Assess for PCA (personal care attendant) services
 - Promote healthy lifestyles for seniors
- Payment programs include Medical Assistance waiver programs: CADI, CAC, TBI, EW and AC.

Family Health

Public health nurses and family service aides provide services to children and families including assessment, teaching, counseling, education, community resource information and referral. Topics include parenting, injury prevention, family planning, pregnancy, child growth and development, children with special needs.
