

FAMILY & GROUP FAMILY CHILD CARE AGE GROUP DEFINITIONS

INFANT means a child who is at **least six weeks of age** but less than 12 months of age.

TODDLER means a child who is at least 12 months old but less than 24 months old for family and group family child care (Class A and Class C1, C2, C3). For specialized infant and toddler family and specialized group family child care (Class B1, B2, and D) a toddler means a child who is at least 12 months old but less than 30 months old.

CLASS

- A 12 months to less than 24 months
- B1 12 months to less than 30 months
- B2 12 months to less than 30 months
- C1 12 months to less than 24 months
- C2 12 months to less than 24 months
- C3 12 months to less than 24 months
- D 12 months to less than 30 months

PRESCHOOLER means a child who is at least 24 months old up to the age of being eligible to enter kindergarten within the next four months (May 10).

SCHOOLAGER means a child who is at least of sufficient age to have attended the first day of kindergarten OR is eligible to enter kindergarten within the next four months (May 10), but is younger than 11 years of age.
