*ANNANDALE (10-08)

- Local Churches Coordinate the Program. The food shelf is located in the Midtown Plaza, intersection of Cherry Ave. and Highway 55, (across from Am-Pride) Annandale, MN 55302.

- Hours are Tuesday 4 - 6 p.m., Wednesday evening 5 - 7 p.m., and Friday 8:30 - 11 a.m. (come early).

- Served up to 6 times per year or as necessary.
- Available to **Annandale, Maple Lake, South Haven, and Silver Creek -in Annandale School district** residents in need of emergency food.
- ***We Care We Share** - This is a free store in Annandale open to anyone in need 320-274-8881. They have mainly clothes, some household items, and may be able to get other items, for people in need. Clients need no ID; just come in and take what they need. It is located on the corner of Highway 55 and Cherry Ave. in Annandale by the food shelf. Hours are Tuesday 3 - 5 p.m., Wednesday 5 - 7 p.m., Friday 8:30 a.m. - 1 p.m. FREE will offering is asked.

*COKATO – Dassel Area (10-08)

- Located at 395 Broadway South, Cokato, MN 55321. The Cokato Area Food Shelf is available for residents in the Dassel/Cokato area. To sign up, they need to call Elim Mission Church at 320-286-2662 Monday through Thursday. Pick up is Friday morning at 9:30. The church office is open 9:00 am-3:00pm. Monday-Thursday, but they must call by Thursday at noon to sign up for that Friday's pick up. It's for emergency use only and proof of residence and children's birth certificates may be required. Use is limited to monthly, with six uses total, after which they are required to meet with one of the area pastors before receiving more help. Save & Share Thrift Shop – Hours: Thursday 1 -7 p.m., Friday 10 a.m. – 5 p.m., Saturday 10 a.m. – 1 p.m. These shop hours are for BOTH donation drop off and shopping. Located at 511 Cokato St. W. (behind the Grounds). (There is a donation asked for items, yet at a reduced price). If you have donation of larger quantity of items call (320) 286-5895 to make an appointment.

DELANO (1-08)
