Minnesota Rule 9502.0435, Subpart 13 D, requires that bleach and water be used when disinfecting the diaper changing area. In order to apply for a variance for other products, Wright County requires that the product must be as effective as bleach and water as a disinfectant. It must be effective against pseudomonas aeruginosa, staphylococcus aureaus, and salmonella cholerae suis. It must have the EPA registration number, kill germs in 10 minutes or less, and have clearly described directions for mixing and use.

You are responsible to ensure that the product is used according to manufacturer's directions.

I choose to use a product other than bleach and water only for diaper changing area as a disinfectant, and agree to use it according to manufacturer's directions.
