Come to the Wright County Compost & Recycling Facility on
Wednesday, August 18, 2010 from 8 a.m. until 3 p.m.

The Wright County Environmental Health Department will accept major household appliances for no charge to help county residents properly dispose of these unwanted items. County residents will be able to drop off a total of **three** appliances per household.

Some appliance products contain mercury switches or ozone depleting refrigerants. When dumped in a landfill or abandoned, these materials can potentially contaminate the soil, groundwater and air. Appliances that have been abandoned in road ditches or dumped in ravines and back in wooded areas are also accepted at this collection event. Each appliance must be emptied of any food or other non related material.

No electronics, household hazardous wastes or recyclable materials will be accepted during this event. This collection is for major household appliances only. All other materials will be turned away.

We will not be requiring appointments for this collection so please be patient if there is a line to drop off appliances. All participants will be served on a first come basis and we will not close early. Simply come to the Wright County Compost & Recycling Facility between 8 a.m. and 3 p.m. on Wednesday, August 18th to properly dispose of any major household appliance you no longer want or need.

This collection is targeted to residents of Wright County. Drivers' licenses may be checked at the collection to confirm Wright County residency. Businesses or other entities should call (320) 963-5797 or (763) 682-7331 before the collection day to determine if their appliances could be accepted at this collection event.
