Objective *

This project request would provide funding for the installation of a new stormwater system outlet for the City of Monticello. This stormwater outlet would replace the current County Ditch #33 outlet, which would ultimately be abandoned, and would allow the continued drainage of the remaining portions of County Ditch #33 as well as any future developments.

The size of the project makes it infeasible for the benefitted landowners on County Ditch #33 to cover the cost of the entire project.

Description *

This project request would provide funding for the installation of a new stormwater system outlet for the City of Monticello. This stormwater outlet would replace the current County Ditch #33 outlet, which would ultimately be abandoned, and would allow the continued drainage of the remaining portions of County Ditch #33 as well as any future developments.

The Wright County Drainage Authority in partnership with the City of Monticello is looking to utilize ARP funding to replace what is currently the outlet for County Ditch #33 with a new stormwater outlet. County Ditch #33 is mostly a tile ditch system built in 1917 with only limit repairs done since construction was completed. The land use change in this area from rural to urban development has increased the pressure on this aging drainage system. This coupled with the lack of repairs has cause flooding issues across the majority of the 9-mile system and has even forced some housing to be condemned. This project would not only help resolve a significant amount of drainage issues along the current ditch alignment but would be large enough to handle any future development.

The proposed project would include funding for approximately 4,600ft of 48in stormwater pipe, the appropriate intake and manhole inspection covers, and easements. This system would be designed, and installation overseen by the City of Monticello with assistance from an outside engineering firm. Matt Detjen from the Division of Agriculture and Drainage will help oversee construction and will monitor all payments to the City of Monticello. The project would likely start in the fall of 2022 and be completed sometime in 2023.
