These funds would be used to monitor, inspect, identify, and implement water quality practices throughout Wright County. This could include urban or rural infrastructure projects, and could also be used outside of infrastructure projects such as lake and stream monitoring. Limited funding is currently available for these types of projects, especially those that require significant investment to identify sources of pollutants. Wright County staff in collaboration with other agencies will identify areas where significant sources of pollutants may be impacting water quality. These funds would then be used to identify and implement strategies to address these sources. The projects would be identified on a case-by-case basis, but two projects are currently in progress that could utilize this funding source. Matt Detjen would oversee the program and allocate funding to top priority projects. These funds will be available until spent.

Success can be measured by the reduction in pollutants, which is often measured in pounds.
