

Installation Assistance

Everyone eligible for the Tenth Judicial District's Ignition Interlock Assistance Program will have the **full cost** of ignition interlock installation paid as long as grant funding remains available.

Monthly Lease Fee Assistance

Applicants may also be eligible to receive help to pay the monthly lease fee of the ignition interlock device for a period of up to one year. This could result in savings to you starting at \$19.95 up to \$71.95/month depending on your household income level.

The Tenth Judicial District has a grant which provides funding for the cost of installation and covers a portion of monthly lease fees – 90% (\$71.95); 50% (\$39.95); or 25% (\$19.95) to eligible participants.

Revoked or Cancelled License: Steps to Install Ignition Interlock

- 1) Must own or have access to a vehicle and that vehicle must be insured.
- 2) Make sure you are eligible to participate in the ignition interlock program: must be 18, have no other withdrawals on your license and must not be subject to Vanessa's law because of a DWI prior to 18.
- 3) Pass DWI knowledge test, pay reinstatement fee, apply for new Class D driver's license, complete chemical use assessment (if required) and purchase new plates if yours were impounded.
- 4) Complete and send to Driver & Vehicle services (DVS) its forms, which differ depending on if your license is cancelled or revoked.
- 5) Complete the Tenth District's Application for Ignition Interlock Assistance (available from the probation department).

The Tenth District Ignition Interlock Technician will contact you after the District's application is received. The Technician is also available to assist at any phase of the process in preparing to install.

Valid License and Court Ordered: Steps to Install Ignition Interlock

- 1) Must own or have access to a vehicle and that vehicle must be insured.

- Resident of Anoka, Chisago, Isanti, Kanabec, Pine, Sherburne, Washington, or Wright County
- Have a criminal case that originated in the Tenth Judicial District
- Legal resident of the United States
- Be on active supervised probation or supervised release
- Complete Tenth Judicial District Application for Ignition Interlock Assistance
