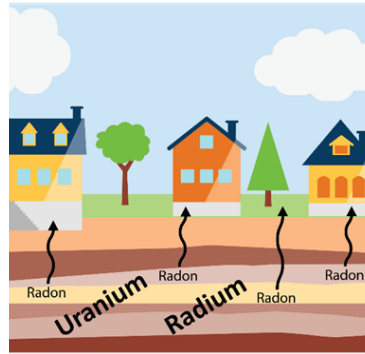


Test Your Home For Radon



Radon is the 2nd leading cause of lung cancer in smokers and the leading cause in non-smokers

Radon is a naturally occurring radioactive soil gas

How often should I test?

- All Minnesota homes should be tested for radon and then retested every 2-5 years (save your test results).
- Test before and after you make home improvements (like finishing a basement, adding on, installing a kitchen vent hood, updating windows or insulation, changing your heating or cooling system.)
- Retest after adding a radon mitigation system to make sure it is working properly.

You can obtain a test kit from the Health & Human Services Department, while supplies last:
