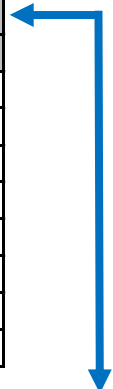

Tires: car, light truck	\$2 / tire

Ballasts (PCB only)	\$2 / lb
Fluorescent lamps	> 10 = \$1 / lamp

- ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED**

 - Business or commercial wastes
 - Mattresses, box springs, or furniture
 - Carpet or padding
 - Construction lumber of any type
 - Railroad ties or landscaping material
 - #6 or unmarked plastics
 - Foam packing peanuts
 - Dirty, greasy or soiled corrugated cardboard

SHARPS

SHARPS include needles, syringes, broken glass, scalpels, culture slides, culture dishes, broken capillary tubes, broken rigid plastic and exposed ends of dental wires.

SHARPS must be placed in a puncture-resistant container designed for **SHARPS** waste.

BEFORE being brought to Wright County's Household Hazardous Waste center, all **SHARPS** containers must be:

- Properly and securely closed (*the use of duct tape is recommended as an extra precaution*)
- Clearly and visibly labeled with the word **SHARPS**

Absolutely NO loose SHARPS are permitted outside of sharps containers.
