

## Adult Foster Care Fire Marshal Inspection

**All Adult Foster Care applicants must have a Fire Marshal inspection of their home.** Please consult with the AFC Licenser regarding which entity can perform that inspection. Certain cities have authorized inspectors, otherwise the State Fire Marshal's Office will need to perform the inspection.

Obtain a **cashier's check, money order or certified bank check for \$50** made payable to the applicable entity. That entity will be decided by conversation with the AFC Licenser.

Submit the fee to Wright County Human Services. ***Personal checks are not accepted.*** Please allow at least 3-4 weeks for the Fire Marshal to contact you to schedule an inspection.
